On March 28, 1978, we met with you to discuss the above-captioned grievance at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure.

The matters presented by you as well as the applicable contractual provisions have been reviewed and given careful consideration.

Management will work with union officials in granting access to postal service facilities in accordance with the language of Article XXIII of the current National Agreement. To enhance effective labor-management relations, there should be no unreasonable delays in management granting a requesting union official access to a U. S. Postal Service facility. This grievance is resolved.
