On September 7, 1983, we met to discuss the above-captioned grievance at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure.

The question raised in this grievance involves the transporting of misthrows to and from the throwback case.

During our discussion, we agreed to the following as a full and final settlement of all matters relating to this dispute:

Carriers will be allowed to return mark-up mail and misthrows to the throwback case or other designated location. Except for "no obvious mail", it is our mutual understanding that the carrier case is not the designated location.


Please sign and return the enclosed copy of this decision as your acknowledgment of agreement to settle this case.
