On November 8, 1983, we met to discuss the above-captioned grievance at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure.

The question in this grievance is whether local management is proper in requiring full-time regular letter carriers to use a tire gauge to check tires for inflation.

During our discussion, it was mutually agreed that the following would represent a full settlement of this case:

The tire check during the carrier's vehicle inspection (Notice 76) is a visual check. Full-time regular carriers will not be required to use a tire gauge to check tire inflation.
