On September 20, 1983, we met to discuss the above-captioned grievances at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure.

The question in these grievances is whether the grievant had the requisite number of years of Postal Service in order to be eligible to apply for permanent reassignment under Article 13, Section 2B, of the National Agreement.


During our discussion, it was mutually agreed that the following would represent a full settlement of these cases:


An employee must have 5 years of cumulative Postal Service in order to be eligible to submit a voluntary request for permanent reassignment to light duty.
