On October 13, 1978, we met with you to discuss the above-captioned grievance at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure.

The matters presented by you as well as the applicable contractual provisions have been reviewed and given careful consideration.

Based on the facts presented and contained in the case file, we find that overtime was scheduled in accordance with the appropriate provisions of Article VIII. There are no requirements that overtime be scheduled according to seniority in the letter carrier craft. In the absence of a contractual violation, this grievance is denied.
