Dear Mr. Johnson:

On March 20, 1985, we met to discuss the above-captioned grievance at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure.

This grievance involves whether carriers at the Eureka office are being improperly required to give supervisors estimated times of departure from and return to the office.

During our discussion, we agreed that requiring carriers to record their daily leaving and returns times would be contrary to a Step 4 resolution reached on case no. HlN-5K-C 6754. We also agreed that there is no prohibition against supervisors asking carriers for estimated leaving and returns times; however, use of the information and/or actions resulting from having the information are appropriate subjects for scrunity under the grievance-arbitration procedures.

As we further agreed, this case is hereby remanded to the parties at Step 3 for application of the above and final resolution.
