Dear Mr. Riley:

On February 3, 1977, we met with you to discuss the above-captioned grievance at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure.

The matters presented by you as well as the applicable contractual provisions have been reviewed and given careful consideration.

During our discussion we agreed that letter carriers may be required to gas up their vehicles. However, we also agreed that letter carriers will not be required to check the oil or otherwise service their vehicles.

Under the circumstances, this case is considered resolved and the grievance closed.
