On April 3, 1981, we met with you to discuss the above-captioned case at the fourth step of the contractual grievance procedure set forth in the 1978 National Agreement.

The question raised in this grievance involves whether the carriers in the office in question are entitled to two fifteen minute breaks by virtue of the previous long-standing practice of granting such breaks in the Moraga Post Office.

Upon review of the issue raised along with other documents provided; including previous route inspection data, it is our determination that the carriers in the Moraga, California Post Office are entitled to 2 fifteen minutes breaks. Appropriate steps to institute these breaks will be made upon receipt of this decision.
