
Dear Mr. Johnson:

On November 6, 1981, you met with Frank Dyer in pre-arbitration discussion of H8N-3P-C-16890. After a thorough discussion of the issue, it was mutually agreed that the following would represent a full settlement of the case.


1. During a special count and inspection where interim adjustments are necessary, the Postal Service may temporarily provide such relief by means of a "hand-off."
2. For purposes of the Overtime Desired List, that portion of any route which is handed off because of Item 1 above will be considered a part of that route through which it is delivered.
