Dear Mr. May:


On October 7, 1975, we met with you to discuss the above-captioned grievance at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure.

The matters presented by you as well as the applicable contractual provisions have been reviewed and given careful consideration.

It is not required that temporary changes in schedule be posted by Wednesday preceeding the week in which the change takes place. However, temporary changes in starting times which require employees to work outside of their basic work week schedule necessitates the payment of overtime for all hours worked outside of the basic schedule. To this extent, we find the grievance is sustained.

By copy of this letter, the Postmaster is instructed to reimburse the carriers involved in this grievance at the rate of time and one-half for all hours worked outside of their schedule during the period that the temporary change in schedule was in effect.
