Dear Mr. Overby:


On November 30, 1981, you met with Frank Dyer in pre-arbitration discussion of H8N-4C-C-22286. It was mutually agreed that the following would represent full settlement of this case:

1. Normally an employee who is detailed as an acting supervisor will not perform bargaining unit work prior to the workday immediately following the termination of the detail.
2. Due to the various situations that could occur, each set of fact circumstances will be determined on a case by case basis.
3. In this instant case, the senior employee who was on the Overtime Desired list on the day of the dispute and did not work overtime will be compensated 2 hours of backpay.

Please sign the attached copy of this letter acknowledging your agreement with this settlement, withdrawing H8N-4C-C-22286 from the pending national arbitration listing.
