On June 22, we had a pre-arbitration discussion of case HIN-4E-C 1360. During these discussions, it was mutually agreed that the following would represent a full settlement of this case:

Carriers with city carrier transportation (driveout) agreements shall be reimbursed for the transportation of all articles in excess of two pounds, whether in relay sacks or not, in accordance with Article 41, Section 4.3.e of the 1981 National Agreement.

Please sign the attached copy of this letter acknowledging your agreement with this settlement and withdrawing HIN-4E-C 1360 from the pending national arbitration list.
