Dear Mr. Overby:


On June 29, you met with Frank Dyer in pre-arbitration discussion of H8N-4E-D-14090, Cleveland, Ohio. The issue in this grievance is whether management is obligated to make a temporary duty assignment available for opting purposes when one of the five (5) days is a holiday.

After a discussion of this issue, it was mutually agreed to full settlement of this grievance as follows:


1. A temporary vacancy of five (5) days or more that includes a holiday may be opted for, per Article 41, Section 2B.
2. It is understood that this settlement does not add to or otherwise amend Article 11, Section 7.

Please sign the attached copy of this letter acknowledging your agreement with this settlement, withdrawing H8N-4E-D-14090 from the pending National arbitration listing.
