Dear Mr. May:

On October 9, 1975, we met with you to discuss the above-captioned grievance at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure.

The matters presented by you as well as the applicable contractual provisions have been reviewed and given careful consideration.

Section 221.131 of Handbook M-39 provides for the inspection of a route on one or more days during the count week. It further provides that the route examiner will count and record the mail on the day(s) of the inspection. However, the carrier will count and record the mail all other days during the count week except on the day(s) of inspection.

Local management has been advised to abide by the provisions of Section 221.131 of the M-39. In accordance with our meeting, this grievance is considered to be resolved.
