Dear Mr. Johnson:

This letter supersedes our decision dated July 9, 1982.

The question raised in this grievance involves the administration of transportation agreements. It was mutually agreed that the following would represent a full settlement of this case:

Carriers with city carrier transportation (drive-out) agreements shall be reimbursed for the transportation of all articles in excess of two pounds, whether in relay sacks or not, in accordance with Article 41, Section 4.3.e, of the 1981 National Agreement. The Postmaster will process this employee's claim for 114 articles at the contractual rate of \$.30 each.

Please sign the attached copy of this decision as your acknowledgment of agreement to resolve this case.
