The matters presented by you as well as the applicable contractual provisions have been reviewed and given careful consideration.


The issue in this grievance involves whether service time under a casual appointment in the performance of carrier duties should count as creditable time when computing the one year's required experience as a city carrier in awarding a carrier technician position. As final settlement in all matters relating to this dispute, the parties at the national level agree to the following resolution:

Total time served performing carrier duties will count toward required experience when awarding carrier technician positions.
