Dear Mr. Rademacher:

As a result of a pre-arbitration discussion on the abovecaptioned grievance, we have mutually agreed to the settlement of this case, without precedent, on the following basis: The grievant will be paid two hours pay at the applicable overtime rate.

The Postal Service reaffirms its intent that supervisors will do as little bargaining unit work as possible and that such work will be performed only under the strict limitations of Article I, Section 6, of the 1973 National Agreement.
