Dear Mr. Overby:

On February 17, 1984, we met to discuss the above-captioned grievance at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure.

The question in this grievance is whether management violated Articles 7 and 8 of the National Agreement by assigning overtime in the carrier craft to the acting Vehicle Operations Maintenance Assistant (VOMA) whose regular position is also in the carrier craft.


During our discussion, it was mutually agreed that the following would represent a full settlement of this case:


The VOMA may be assigned overtime in the carrier craft after the provisions of Article 8, Section 5, have been satisfied.

Please sign and return the enclosed copy of this letter as your acknowledgment of agreement to settle this case.
