On March 10, 1977, we met with you to discuss the above-captioned grievance at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure.

The matters presented by you as well as the applicable contractual provisions have been reviewed and given careful consideration.

The ~~record analysis~~ (Forms 1840B) should be taken during normal mail volume periods between the first week of September and May, 31, excluding December. The record shows in this case that the six week analysis was not taken from the appropriate time period. To this extent, the grievance is sustained.

By copy of this letter local officials are notified to ensure that during future route examinations the six week analysis is taken from the appropriate time period.
