On September 13, 1977, we met with you to discuss the above-captioned grievance at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure.

The matters presented by you as well as the applicable contractual provisions have been reviewed and given careful consideration.

Based on the evidence contained in this grievance, we find that under the specific factual circumstances involved, that is when the transactor unit is malfunctioning, employees will be allowed to clock-in on Form 1260 as provided in the M-39 Handbook Section 215.2.

Therefore, it is our conclusion that the issues raised in this grievance are resolved and the grievance is closed.
