
On December 15, 1981, you met with Howard R. Carter in a pre-arbitration discussion of H8N-3P-C-32705. During these discussions, it was mutually agreed that the following would represent a full settlement of the case:

1. Details of anticipated duration of one week (five working days within seven calendar days) or longer to temporarily vacant Carrier Technician (T-6) positions shall be filled per Article XXV, 1981 National Agreement.
2. When such temporary details involve a schedule change for the detailed employee, that employee will assume the hours of the vacancy without obligation to the employer for out-of-schedule overtime.
3. This settlement language will resolve any and all like cases of this issue pending national arbitration.

Please sign the attached copy of this letter acknowledging your agreement with this settlement, withdrawing H8N-3P-C-32705 from the pending national arbitration list.
