Dear Mr. Overby:

On April 20, 1983, we met to discuss the above-captioned case at the fourth step of the contractual grievance procedure set forth in the 1981 National Agreement.


The question raised in this grievance involves whether part-time flexible employees have the right to opt for T/6 positions under Article 41, Section 2.B.4., of the National Agreement.


After further review of this matter, we mutually agreed that no national interpretive issue is fairly presented in the particulars evidenced in this case. The parties agree that temporary vacancies occurring in T/6 positions are filled in accordance with Article 25, Section 4, of the National Agreement. This case is remanded to the parties at Step 3 for application of the above understanding.

Accordingly, as we further agreed, this case is hereby remanded to the parties at Step 3 for further processing, if necessary.
