Dear Mr. Hughes:

Recently, we met on the above-captioned case at the fourth step of the contractual grievance procedure set forth in the 1978 National Agreement.

The question raised in this grievance involves whether or not management violated the provisions of Article XVII, Section 2, of the National Agreement by limiting the scope of the Chief Steward's representation to the station at which he had been certified.


After further review of this matter, we mutually agreed that no National interpretive issue is fairly presented in the particulars evidenced in this case as the designation of Chief Steward does not provide for added representation beyond the particular designated work location.

Accordingly, as we further agreed, this case is hereby remanded to the parties at Step 3 for further processing if necessary. Please sign a copy of this letter as your acknowledgment of agreement to remand this case.
