On October 21, 1985, we met to discuss the above-captioned grievance at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure.

The issue in this grievance is whether a bid assignment was improperly denied the grievant while serving as an employee involvement facilitator.

During our discussion, we mutually agreed to settle this case based on our understanding that in this instance the grievant was entitled to exercise his bidding rights as set forth in Article 41.

Accordingly, this case is hereby remanded to Step 3 for application of the above settlement to the facts involved and appropriate overtime action.
