On August 23, 1977, we met with you to discuss the above-captioned grievance at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure.

Based on the evidence presented in this grievance, we find that local management will instruct employees on light or limited duty to perform only duties which are permitted by the instructions of the physician on Form 2533.
