On November 22, 1983, we met to discuss the above-captioned grievance at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure.

The question in this grievance is whether management has improperly required the grievant to prepare "marriage" mail for street delivery while on the street.

During our discussion, it was mutually agreed that the following would represent a full settlement of this case:

The parties at this level agree that marriage mailings received on park and loop routes are handled in accordance with the April 17, 1980, settlement agreement concerning Simplified Address Mail.




