Dear Mr. Overby:

On April 18, 1984, we met to discuss the above-captioned grievance at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure.

The grievance concerns whether the grievant has exceeded his contractual right to become a successful bidder more than 5 times during the life of the Agreement. (Article 12, Section 3.)

We mutually agreed that this grievance does not fairly present an interpretive dispute. The bidding restrictions of Article 12, Section 3, pertain only to those positions posted for bid pursuant to Article 41, Section 1.B.2. Other types of local in section bidding or bidding pursuant to Article 41, Section 2.B., are not included.

Accordingly, we further agreed to remand this case to Step 3 for a determination to be made based on fact circumstances.
