The question raised in this grievance is whether management must initiate a T/6 program in a post office where a T/6 position has not been established.


During our discussion, it was mutually agreed that the following would represent a full settlement of this case:


Nothing precludes the union from requesting that the T/6 program be initiated. The decision to initiate the program, however, rests solely with management.
