Dear Mr. Johnson:

On August 3, 1984, we met to discuss the above-captioned grievance at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure.

The question in this grievance is whether management improperly denied "seasoned" postal employees to retake the end-of-training test (TD-287C).

During our discussion, it was mutually agreed that the following would represent a full settlement of this case:

Under Section III.C.5.a of Management Instruction EL-830-83-11, "[a]11 driver candidates . . . must pass the end-of-training test (TD-287C... and TD-287D...) . . . The word "candidates" is intended to apply to newly hired employees only.

Please sign and return the enclosed copy of this letter as your acknowledgment of agreement to settle this case.

Time limits were extended by mutual consent.
