On June 7, 1985, we met to discuss the above-captioned grievance at the fourth step of the contractual grievance procedure.

The issue in this grievance is whether management may require carriers to remain at a precise location during their lunch period.

During our discussion, we mutually agreed:

Carriers are permitted to pursue personal activities within applicable postal requlations during their authorized lunch period as long as there is no additional expense to the Postal Service; the assigned vehicle is parked at the authorized park point, and; the mail is properly secured.
