
On March 29, 1977, we met with you to discuss the above-captioned grievance at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure.

The matters presented by you as well as the applicable contractual provisions have been reviewed and given careful consideration.

Although unusual circumstances may warrant an exception, generally special inspections shall be conducted in the same manner as the annual count and inspection. The route may be inspected on more than one day of the week and the examiner will count and record the mail on those days. The carrier should count and record the mail on all other days during the count week.

In accordance with the above, this grievance is considered to be resolved.
