On July 14, 1977, we met with you to discuss the above-captioned greivance at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure.

The matters presented by you as well as the applicable contractual provisions have been reviewed and given careful consideration.

It is our position that requiring carriers to place a map of their delivery area in the route book and to mark the map with the line of travel is not in violation of the National Agreement. Under the circumstances, the grievance is denied.
