
Dear Mr. Johnson:

On May 4, 1977 we met with you to discuss the above-captioned grievance at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure.

The matters presented by you as well as the applicable contractual provisions have been reviewed and given careful consideration.

Generally, the canceling of stamps is a minor function with a negligible amount of time involved. Consequently, it would not adversely effect the carrier's overall office time. If for some reason a significant volume is received on a regular basis, the matter should be brought to local management's attention for other corrective action.
