Dear Mr. Johnson:

On August 4, 1977, we met with you to discuss the above-captioned grievance at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure.

The matters presented by you as well as the applicable contractual provisions have been reviewed and given careful consideration.

Based on the evidence presented in this grievance, we find that in future route examinations at the Boca Raton Station the local union will be notified by letter of the dates of the route examinations. Carriers will be instructed with dry-run instructions as set forth in the M-39 Handbook. Whenever possible a different month each year is preferred for the annual route inspections.

In addition, when cases are remanded for discussion at Step 2A, the local union will be notified and a discussion will be held with the appropriate officials of the local union.

Therefore, the issues raised in this grievance are resolved and the grievance is closed.
