Dear Mr. Overby:

On April 23, 1987, we met to discuss the above-captioned grievance at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure.

The issue in this grievance is whether management utilized casuals in lieu of PTF carriers.

After reviewing this matter, we mutually agreed that no national interpretive issue is fairly presented in this case. This is a dispute suitable for regional determination by application of the Senior Assistant Postmaster General's Memorandum dated June 22, 1976, concerning the utilization of casual employees.

Accordingly, we agreed to remand this case to the parties at Step 3 for further processing.

Time limits were extended by mutual consent.
