On September 9, 1987, we met to discuss the above captioned grievance at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure.


This grievance involves an order to the grievant to leave unaccountable parcels with apartment managers without attempting delivery.


During our discussion, we agreed to settle this case based on our understanding that parcels will be delivered to the addressee or his or her authorized agent. We also agreed that the authorized agent may be an apartment manager.

Accordingly, we agreed to remand the case to the parties at Step 3 for application of the above and resolution.
