Dear Mr. Tunstall:

On several occasions, the most recent being April 10, 1987, we met to discuss the above-captioned grievance at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure.

The issue in this grievance is whether local management violated the National Agreement by denying a former employee, who is a certified union steward, access to the Flushing, New York, Post Office.

During our discussion, we mutually agreed that the following constitutes full and final settlement of this case:

The individual named in this grievance will be allowed to enter the facility to perform the functions of a steward or chief steward in accordance with the provisions of Article 17.2D.
