Dear Mr. Overby:

On July 9, 1985, we met to discuss the above-captioned grievance at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure.

The issue in this grievance is whether full-time regular employees may be required to work overtime on more than five (5) days if the workdays are part of two service weeks.

During our discussion, we mutually agreed with reference to Article 8, Section 5.F of the 1981 National Agreement, ". . . no full-time regular employee will be required to work overtime on more than five (5) consecutive days in a week." There is no requirement that the five days must be within the same service week.
