Recently, I met with your representative Brian Farris, to discuss the above-captioned grievance at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure.

The issue in this grievance is whether management violated the National Agreement when it assigned a former supervisor to a Full-Time regular carrier position at the Kenner, Louisiana office.


After reviewing this matter, we mutually agreed that no national interpretive issue is fairly presented in this case.
