Dear Mr. Farris:

On September 2, 1987, we met to discuss the above-captioned grievance at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure.

The issue in this grievance is whether management improperly authorized more than one management representative to meet with the grievant and designated union steward at a Step 1 meeting.

After reviewing this matter, we mutually agreed that no national interpretive issue is fairly presented in this case. This is a local issue which may be resolved by application of the agreement reached in case no. H8N-3U-C 16250 (copy attached).

Accordingly, we agreed to remand this case to the parties at Step 3 for further processing, including arbitration if necessary.


