Dear Mr. Overby:

On April 23, 1987, we met to discuss the above-captioned grievance at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure.

The issue in this grievance is whether the bill submitted to the union by management for copies and processing of information was excessive.

After reviewing this matter, we mutually agreed that no national interpretive issue is fairly presented in this case. This is a dispute suitable for regional determination by application of Section 352.621 thru 352.633 of the Administrative Support Manual to the fact circumstances.

Accordingly, we agreed to remand this case to the parties at Step 3 for further processing, including arbitration, if necessary.
