The subject case is settled based upon the following understanding.

In the administration of Article 1, Section 6.B., of the National Agreement, the parties agree to the following principle:

If the phrase "distribution tasks" or "may personally perform non-supervisory tasks" is found in a supervisor's position description, this does not mean the casing of mail into letter carrier cases.

It is understood and agreed that the above resolution and settlement is between the United States Postal Service and the National Association of Letter Carriers and is not intended to reflect in any way an interpretation of the collective bargaining agreement with any other union.

Please sign and return the enclosed copy of this letter as your acknowledgment of agreement to remand this case.
