Dear Mr. Hutchins:

Recently, Andrea Wilson met with you in prearbitration discussion of case number HlN-NA-C 89. The question in this case is whether Management violated the National Agreement by implementing the Router Program without having bargained its terms with the National Association of Letter Carriers (NALC), APL-CIO.

It was mutually agreed that the following represents full settlement of this case and those cases on the enclosed list:

All router assignments posted prior to the July 21, 1987, Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between the NALC and the U.S. Postal Service are also subject to the MOU on router assignments.

Management shall list specific groups of routes and where applicable specific street duties for each router assignment whenever that information was not previously listed.

A determination as to whether these assignments shall be reposted will be made on an individual basis through mutual agreement by local management and the Union within 90 days of this agreement.

Please sign and return the enclosed copy of this letter acknowledging your agreement to withdraw HIN-NA-C 89 from the pending national arbitration listing and the enclosed list of cases from the grievance procedure.
