Dear Mr. Sombrotto:

Recently, a meeting was held with the NALC Director of City Delivery, Brian Farris, to discuss the above-captioned grievance which is currently being held in abeyance at the National Level.

The issue in this grievance is whether management violated the National Agreement by sending home a letter concerning absenteeism to employees at home.

During the discussion, it was agreed that the following would represent full and final settlement of this case:

Each employee in the carrier craft currently assigned to the Lansing, MI Post Office who was on the rolls as of January 24, 1986, will be granted pay for ten minutes at the straight time rate.


This settlement is nonciteable, nonprecedential, and is made without prejudice to the positions of either party.


Accordingly, we agreed to remand this case to the parties at Step 3 for implementation of this settlement.
