Recently, a meeting was held with the NALC Director of City Delivery, Brian Farris, to discuss the above-captioned grievance at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure.

The issue in this grievance is whether management violated Article 11 of the National Agreement by failing to post a holiday schedule in a timely manner.

After reviewing this matter, we mutually agreed that no national interpretive issue is fairly presented in this case. We agreed that management has an obligation to post a holiday schedule for December 25.

Accordingly, we agreed to remand this case to the parties at Step 3 for further processing, consistent with the above.
