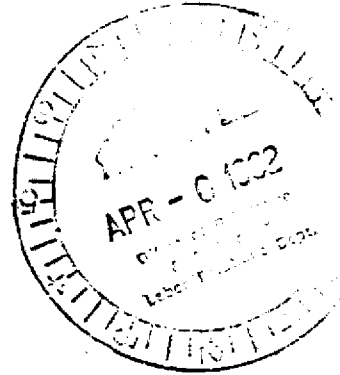

Dear Mr. Anderson:


On March 30, you met with Frank Dyer in pre-arbitration discussion of H8C-3P-C-16794. The issue in this grievance involves the additional duties performed by a VOMA.


After a discussion of the issue, it was mutually agreed to full settlement of this grievance as follows:

Although the employee in this position may be required to participate in mail processing functions (regardless of his craft), his primary duty should be to perform vehicle operations and maintenance functions.

Please sign the attached copy of this letter acknowledging your agreement with this settlement, withdrawing this case from the pending national arbitration listing.
