A prearbitration discussion was held in connection with the above-captioned grievance.

The issue in this case is whether the issuance of temporary drivers' licenses (Form OP-346) is consistent with the Handbook EL-827.

During the discussion, it was mutually agreed to settle the grievance and withdraw the case from the national pending arbitration listing. The settlement is based on the following understanding.

The parties agree that Handbook EL-827 provides sufficient procedures for licensing of postal drivers. Accordingly, the parties agree that there does not exist sufficient cause for instituting temporary drivers' licenses. The temporary licenses will, therefore, be rescinded.

The issue in this case is whether the issuance of temporary drivers' licenses (Form OF-346) is consistent with the Handbook EL-827.


During the discussion, it was mutually agreed to settle the grievance and withdraw the case from the national pending arbitration listing. The settlement is based on the following understanding.
