Dear Mr. Sombrotto:

Recently, a meeting was held with the NALC Director of City Delivery, Brian Farris, to discuss the above-captioned grievance at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure.

The issue in this grievance is whether the terms and conditions of Article 25 were violated when the grievant, T-6, was not detailed to a vacant VOMA position.

After reviewing this matter, we mutually agreed that no national interpretive issue is fairly presented in this case. Higher level positions are to be filled in accordance with Article 25. It should be noted, however, that the grievant would not have been entitled for a Higher Level assignment, inasmuch as he is a level 6 and the VOMA position in question is ranked as a level 6.

Accordingly, we agreed to remand this case to the parties at Step 3 for further processing, including arbitration if necessary.

Please sign and return the enclosed copy of this letter as your acknowledgment of agreement to remand this case.

Time limits were extended by mutual consent.
