Dear Mr. Sombrotto:

Recently, a meeting was held with the NALC Director of City Delivery, Brian Farris, to discuss the above-captioned grievance at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure.

The issue in this grievance is whether management violated Article 41 by failing to change the grievant's starting time to the starting time of the regular carrier of a route which the grievant carried as a Carrier Technician (T-6).

During our discussion, we mutually agreed that the starting time(s) of a T-6 carrier should be the starting time(s) of the component routes which comprise the T-6 assignment. Accordingly, we agreed to remand this case to the parties at Step 3 for further processing, including arbitration if necessary, in accordance with the above understanding.

Please sign and return the enclosed copy of this decision as your acknowledgment of agreement to remand this case.

Time limits were extended by mutual consent.
