Recently, a meeting was held with the NALC Director of City Delivery, Brian Farris, to discuss the above-captioned grievance at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure.


The issue in this grievance is whether under these specific fact circumstances, the operation of a paper folding machine by supervisors violates the National Agreement.

Without prejudice to either parties position in any other case, we agree that the work performed is bargaining unit work. This grievance is remanded to the parties at Step 3 to determine what remedy, if any, is appropriate.

Time limits were extended by mutual consent.
